Green Light for Front Lane Crossing



Following the community campaign earlier this year to install a pedestrian crossing in Front Lane, the actions turned into reality last month when the Highways Advisory Committee, following consultation, unanimously agreed to proceed with the installation. The campaign was initiated by local resident Simon Ward following a number of collisions at the location near Kings Gardens, the most recent involving a 12-year-old schoolboy. Over 1,000 residents signed a petition to introduce a safe crossing point for the many school children and elderly residents who use the route going to schools, the doctor's surgery and the Cranham community centre.

I attended the Highways Advisory Committee meeting along with local resident Jonathan Walsh, where Jonathan addressed the committee in support of the proposal.

Front Lane is a very busy route where excessive speed has been an ongoing issue. The crossing will not only provide safe passage for residents, but will have the additional advantage of slowing traffic down along this stretch of road. The community have been totally behind this campaign and it is testimony to the marvellous collective efforts of residents that the much needed crossing, to be placed near Dorkins Way, will now become a reality. Well done to all! Work on the crossing, which is funded by Transport for London, is expected to be complete early next year.

London City Airport

Further to the item on City Airport and the planned changes to flight paths affecting parts of Havering in last months Bulletin, I am pleased to report that in response to a Council Motion put down by our Residents Group in November, there was unanimous support for seeking an extension to the consultation process to allow residents to have their say. The Leader of the Council has written a strongly worded letter to City Airport operators asking for the consultation period to be extended until the end of January. Redbridge and Waltham Forest Councils have written similar letters on this. These changes will have the effect of narrowing the flight paths used by City Airport so that some parts of the Borough will have a reduction in noise and disturbance while others will have a significant increase. The Council is planning to invite the City Airport operators to hold a public meeting in Havering so that the details of parts of the

Lexington Way Planning Proposal

An outline planning application P.1596.14 has been submitted to the Council to develop the green at the rear of Lexington Way and Roseberry Gardens. Upminster Police report

We welcome Sgt Steve Mangham to the ward as our new Sergeant. Over the past two months there has been a slight increase in burglary, most of these have taken place during the day, by rear entrance. Small items such as laptops, mobile phones and jewellery being taken. There has been a good arrest of two suspects following residents alerting the

police. Residents should ensure that doors are securely locked and windows closed when they are out. There has been a significant reduction in thefts from motor vehicle thefts but an increase in theft of motor vehicles. There are examples of people still leaving property on display in their cars and failing to lock them. Ward priorities remain as Burglary, motor vehicle crime and road safety which includes speeding and use of mobile phones. Some speeding tickets have been issued in Corbets Tey Road. Upminster remains a low crime area but with the darker nights it is important to ensure everyone takes sensible precautions to keep themselves and their property safe. 



Waking your tortoise from hibernation

With spring just around the corner, for those of us with Mediterranean Tortoises tucked away in hibernation this can be a tricky time of the year. Warm spells can lead to tortoises waking early only to then be subjected to freezing temperatures days later. It is best to check your tortoises regularly from February onwards and any that are showing signs of waking such as moving about or urinating should be taken out of hibernation and kept warm. It is important not to just put them outside at this time of year but keep them under a heat lamp until the weather warms up. If we have a long cold spring it may be necessary to wake tortoises rather than let them continue in a long hibernation which will leave them weak and prone to disease when they do finally become active. looks set to become a bye-law in Havering. I first raised this at full Council in March 2012, then June 2013 and again in 2014 and am pleased that Havering, along with other London councils, are set to adopt these powers. Spitting in public is a foul habit

which should be discouraged. Until 1990 it was actually a criminal offence to spit in public and carried a fine of £5. Since that law was removed from the statute book no new law has been introduced until now. The provisional penalty would be a £80 fixed penalty, however it is recognised that there needs to be a degree of 'reasonableness' about any such enforcement.

Licencing **Committee**

The granting of licences is an important responsibility which the council has to exercise. The Licencing committee has eleven Members, all who have to receive training, given the function of the committee is quasi-judicial. Licences are required for many

activities, including the sale of alcohol, music and dance, late night refreshments as well as scrap metal and gambling and many more. Much of this is routine and carried out by officers, however where valid objections are received from responsible authorities such as the police or trading standards or members of the public or councillors, a Member subcommittee hearing is required. This consists of the Chairman and two other members of the licencing committee. As Chairman I sit on all sub committees except where the licence is for Upminster, as ward councillor I am precluded given the potential for conflict of interest. Over the past five years, the average number of subcommittee hearings per year has been 33. In granting a licence the sub-committee can set a range of conditions which are enforceable, they can also review a licence and can revoke it if there have been breaches in the conditions. Any decision of the sub-committee can be challenged in the Magistrates Court. In addition there are normally two or three



School Places for Upminster Pupils

With proposed expansions to local primary schools resurfacing again maybe it is time to consider whether it is really necessary. Only a couple of years ago 5.5 million was spent to expand Branfil Primary to 3 form entry and replace the dilapidated infant accommodation. However, since expansion Branfil have failed to fill their increased places. This academic year only 76 of the 90 places were allocated with 20% of the allocation being to Thurrock pupils. Last year was a similar story.

It is a fact that in Upminster and Cranham today many pupils at local schools are not local children. The population of Upminster is generally older and with no mass house building taking place the population is not rising.

One must ask, at a time when Havering Council is forced to make massive cuts, should we, Havering ratepayers have to fund expansion to Upminster schools for the benefit of Thurrock residents. Maybe it is time to follow Wandsworth and consider scrapping the sibling rule to Havering Schools Admissions policy.


