

From the New Year, Automatic Number Plate Recognition (ANPR) cameras will be in use at your local Reuse and Recycling Centre (RRC)



If you live in the boroughs of Barking & Dagenham, Havering, Newham or Redbridge, you are able to use the following Reuse and Recycling Centres:

- ✓ Frizlands Lane, Dagenham
- ✓ Gerpins Lane, Upminster
- ✓ Jenkins Lane, Barking
- ✓ Chigwell Road, Woodford Bridge

As a resident you are able to dispose of your household waste at these sites free of charge. The disposal of this waste is paid for through your council tax.

Waste that is created by traders cannot be tipped for free, and by not declaring it as trade they are acting illegally. We strive to prevent traders from using your RRCs without paying and they are entitled to open an account to pay for disposal of their waste responsibly at these sites.

Each tonne of waste traders fraudulently deposit costs you the taxpayer over £130, and more if it goes to landfill. ANPR cameras will be used to identify and challenge vehicles suspected to be carrying trade waste, including those using cars and small vans.

ANPR data will also help in establishing traffic patterns and identifying busy periods so that we can more effectively manage queues and run our RRCs as efficiently as possible.

Please remember to bring either a current council tax bill or driving licence with you as proof of residence when you visit. You will need authorisation from your Local Authority to tip certain types of waste
